As part of a broader series on Covid-19 and regulation, the objective of this webinar is to discuss more specifically about the current and future challenges for inspections, enforcement and regulatory delivery, looking at the experience of a number of regulatory domains, agencies and countries during the emergency.

Regulatory enforcement and delivery, as well as regulatory compliance, are particularly critical during the emergency, but traditional tools are difficult to use or downright inadequate. Going forward, recovery and preparedness may call for significant changes compared to the pre-crisis practices.

The aim is to understand what can constitute better regulatory delivery approaches and tools to tackle the crisis along with what might represent a “new normality”, looking specifically at fields such as health care supervision, food safety, product safety, but also regulatory inspections more generally.
